“Readers looking for a terrific Bordeaux blanc should snatch up the 2017 Chateau Puygueraud Blanc as it's clean, refreshing, and a beautiful representation of this region, all while not breaking the bank. The blend is 85% Sauvignon Blanc and 15% Sauvignon Gris, aged in tank, and it's going to keep for 2-3 years.”
