“The 2009 is impressive, but the estate somewhat under-the-radar, since it is hard to pronounce and not exactly a household name. This is a beautifully fleshy wine with loads of liquorice, spring flowers, graphite and black fruits. Fleshier and more concentrated than usual, with a longer, more intense finish and plenty of glycerine, this dark ruby/purple wine is a knock-out and, in theory, an attractive great value. It should drink well for up to a decade.”
