“A bright and intense white with dried lemon, stone, salt and grapefruit character. Full body, phenolic tension. Flavorful finish. Very minerally. 60% sauvignon blanc and 40% semillon.”

“The 2015 Puygueraud Blanc is a blend of 60% Sauvignon Blanc and 40% Sauvignon Gris picked at 50 hectoliters per hectare. It has a crisp and fresh grapefruit and passion fruit scented bouquet that is a sheer delight - particularly thanks to the underrated Sauvignon Gris. The palate is very fresh on the entry with crisp acidity, great tension and animation with grapefruit, melon and citrus fruit all lining up to be savored on the finish. What a lovely white Francs Côtes de Bordeaux. I expect it to land at the top of my banded score.”

“The assemblage here is 60% Sauvignon Blanc and 40% Sauvignon Gris. A beautifully fresh nose, all melon and pear fruit, with a white-pepper and white-peach edge. The palate is fresh, characterful, with lovely flesh and substance, and a fine textural weight. It has moderate acidity at best, although it is there, adding to the backbone. Overall though it has a rather fleshy and plush presence, in the style of the vintage, showing the same soft weight in the finish.”
