“This is the first vintage for the white wine at this estate. The blend is 55% Sauvignon Blanc and 45% Sauvignon Gris. Aged in steel and cement vat only, for 7 months, on the lees, with bâtonnage. Rather fragrant fruit here, but in a very dry, leafy, somewhat papery style, with a lightly steely, white-stone undercurrent. Immediately apparent and attractive acidity on the palate, fresh and bright, with a supple and rather reserved texture, a wine majoring on acid freshness and lift rather than fatness or fruit. **Fresh, bright, lively**, very much a wine for fish or oysters. A pithy, challenging finish. From my Bordeaux 2013 assessment at two years.”
